Want honest elections? - ERIC must go!



Time to call your local NC legislators to urge that they support **H.396**, Rep. Mitchell Setzer's (Dist. 89) bill to block ERIC, the Electronic Registration Information Center, alleged to be a front for left-wing voter registration and data manipulation.

Rep. Mitchell Setzer introduced HOUSE BILL 396, AN ACT TO REPEAL THE AUTHORIZATIONS FOR THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ELECTRONIC REGISTRATION INFORMATION CENTER.

The bill states that "the State Board of Elections may not enter into any agreement, membership, or other participation in the Electronic Registration Information Center (ERIC) unless approved by an act of the General Assembly."

NCFRW Endorsement Policies

The campaign season has started. Club Presidents and Campaign Chairs, a reminder from our bylaws:

"Club Presidents, Campaign Activities Chairs and

clubs shall not publicly endorse any candidate in Republican primaries, runoff elections, and special elections, and/or nonpartisan elections when more than one Republican is in the race.

Individual members may work for the candidate of their choice in Republican primaries, but not in the name of the Local Club or NCFRW. "



In Intra-Party (NCGOP) races, all members, as individuals, may endorse a candidate, just not in the name of a club or the NCFRW.
